

Resolution 2017-04
Surplus Equipment/Reprographics

WHEREAS, *Idaho Code* §31-807 vests the Board of County Commissioners with the power and authority to manage real and personal property for the benefit of the County; and

WHEREAS, *Idaho Code* §31-829 provides that whenever any elected official has any personal property belonging to the county under his/her jurisdiction or control which, in his/her judgment, is of no further use to the County, he/she may, with the consent of the Board of County Commissioners, have the property declared as surplus and dispose of the property through sale or other means; and

WHEREAS, *Idaho Code* §31-808 provides that property classified as being under \$250.00 may be sold through a private sale without notice of public auction; and

WHEREAS, Kootenai County Reprographics has in its possession a Pitney Bowes mail machine/meter, asset tag #4137 which is currently not usable and due to age, not able to be repaired, is fully depreciated, and therefore has outlived its usefulness to the County; and

WHEREAS, the estimated total value of the equipment is less than \$250.00; and

WHEREAS, Kootenai County Reprographics desires to have the above referenced property declared as surplus;

NOW THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED that the item referenced hereinabove be, and hereby is, declared to be surplus property, and in accordance therewith, the Board of County Commissioners may take action to dispose of said item by public or private sale, or by another means, in accordance with Idaho law.
