

**Resolution 2017-18**  
**Surplus Vehicle and Asset Deletion/Information Technology**

**WHEREAS**, *Idaho Code* §31-807 vests the Board of County Commissioners with the power and authority to manage real and personal property for the benefit of the County; and

**WHEREAS**, *Idaho Code* §31-829 provides that whenever any elected official has any personal property belonging to the county under his/her jurisdiction or control which, in his/her judgment, is of no further use to the county, he/she may, with the consent of the Board of County Commissioners, have the property declared as surplus and dispose of the property through sale or other means; and

**WHEREAS**, *Idaho Code* §31-808 provides that property classified as being under \$250.00 may be sold through a private sale without notice of public auction; and

**WHEREAS**, the Kootenai County Information Technology Department has on its asset list one (1) 1996 Ford Windstar Van, Asset tag #3313, VIN 2FMDA51U8TBB71607 which has outlived its usefulness to the department; and

**WHEREAS**, due to age and poor condition, it is the recommendation of the Sheriff's Auto Shop that the vehicle not be transferred to another department; and

**WHEREAS**, the Kootenai County Information Technology Department desires to have the above-referenced item declared as surplus property, disposed of pursuant to law, and removed from the County's asset list;

**NOW THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED** that the item referenced hereinabove be, and hereby is declared to be surplus property, and in accordance therewith, the Board of County Commissioners may take action to dispose of said item by public or private sale, or by another means, in accordance with Idaho law and remove the same from the County's list of assets.
