

Resolution 2017-49
Surplus Office Furniture/Assessor

WHEREAS, *Idaho Code* §31-807 vests the Board of Commissioners with the power and authority to manage real and personal property for the benefit of the County; and

WHEREAS, *Idaho Code* §31-829 provides that whenever any elected official has any personal property belonging to the county under his/her jurisdiction or control which, in his/her judgment, is of no further use to the County; her/she may, with the consent of the Board of County Commissioners, have the property declared as surplus and dispose of the property through sale or other means; and

WHEREAS, *Idaho Code* §31-808 provides that property classified as being under \$250.00 may be sold through a private sale without notice of public auction; and

WHEREAS, the Kootenai County Assessor's Office has in its possession one (1) Designcrafts bench, asset tag #3720 which due to age is worn out, fully depreciated and has outlived its usefulness to the County; and

WHEREAS, the estimated total of the value of the office furniture is less than \$250.00; and

WHEREAS, the Kootenai County Assessor's Office desires to have the above referenced property declared as surplus;

NOW THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED that the item referenced hereinabove be, and hereby is, declared to be surplus property, and in accordance therewith, the Board of County Commissioners may take action to dispose of said items by public or private sale, or by another means, in accordance with Idaho law.
