

Resolution 2017-54
Surplus Vehicle/Asset Deletion/Community Development

WHEREAS, *Idaho Code* §31-807 vests the Board of County Commissioners with the power and authority to manage real and personal property for the benefit of the County; and

WHEREAS, *Idaho Code* §31-829 provides that whenever any elected official has any personal property belonging to the county under his/her jurisdiction or control which, in his/her judgment, if of no further use to the county, he/she may, with the consent of the Board of County Commissioners, have the property declared as surplus and dispose of the property through sale or other means; and

WHEREAS, Kootenai County Community Development has on its asset list one (1) 2003 Dodge Dakota, VIN 1D7GG16X53S219006, Asset tag #3845 which due to age and safety concerns has outlived its usefulness to the county; and

WHEREAS, the vehicle is in poor condition and not worth the cost of repair; and

WHEREAS, the market value of this vehicle is greater than \$250.00; and

WHEREAS, Kootenai County Community Development desires to have the above referenced item declared as surplus property and disposed of pursuant to Idaho law;

NOW THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED that the item referenced hereinabove be, and hereby is, declared to be surplus property, and in accordance therewith, the Board of County Commissioners may take action to dispose of said item by public auction, in accordance with Idaho law. If sold item is unable to be sold at public auction, it may then be sold by public or private sale, or by another means.
