

**Resolution 2017-56**  
**Surplus Equipment/Buildings & Grounds**

**WHEREAS**, *Idaho Code* §31-808 vests the Board of County Commissioners with the power and authority to manage real and personal property for the benefit of the County; and,

**WHEREAS**, *Idaho Code* §31-829 provides that whenever any elected official has any personal property belonging to the county under his/her jurisdiction or control which, in his/her judgment, is of no further use to the county, he/she may, with the consent of the Board of County Commissioners, have the property declared as surplus and dispose of the property through sale or other means; and

**WHEREAS**, Kootenai County Buildings and Grounds has on its asset list (1) one 1979 utility trailer, Asset tag # 3143 which due to age and condition has outlived its' usefulness to the County; and

**WHEREAS**, the estimated total value of the equipment is less than \$250.00; and

**WHEREAS**, Kootenai County Buildings and Grounds desires to have the above referenced property declared as surplus;

**NOW THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED** that the item referenced hereinabove be, and hereby is, declared to be surplus property, and in accordance therewith, the Board of County Commissioners may take action to dispose of said item by public or private sale, or by another means, in accordance with Idaho law.
