

Resolution 2017-59
Veteran Service Office/Fleet Management

WHEREAS, *Idaho Code* §31-808 vests the Board of County Commissioners with the power and authority to manage real and personal property for the benefit of the County; and,

WHEREAS, *Idaho Code* §31-829 provides that whenever any elected official has any personal property belonging to the county under his/her jurisdiction or control which, in his/her judgment, is of no further use to the county, he/she may, with the consent of the Board of County Commissioners, have the property declared as surplus and dispose of the property through sale or other means; and

WHEREAS, the Kootenai County Veteran Service Office has in its possession a 1997 Nissan Altima, VIN 1N4BU31DXVC123025, which, due to age, repair and safety concerns is of no further use to the County; and

WHEREAS, the vehicle described hereinabove have a value in excess of \$250.00; and

WHEREAS, the sale of the vehicle could generate additional income for the County; and

WHEREAS, the Kootenai County Veteran Service Office desires to have the vehicle declared as surplus property, deleted from the County's asset list, and as such to be disposed of by sale at public auction;

NOW THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED that the vehicle identified hereinabove be, and hereby is, removed from the County's list of assets and declared to be surplus property and, in accordance therewith, the Board of County Commissioners may take action to dispose of the vehicle through public auction to the highest bidder, after advertising the same, in accordance with Idaho law.
