

Resolution 2017-60
Surplus Vehicle/Buildings & Grounds

WHEREAS, *Idaho Code* §31-807 vests the Board of County Commissioners with the power and authority to manage real and personal property for the benefit of the County; and

WHEREAS, *Idaho Code* 31-829 provides that whenever any elected official has any personal property belonging to the county under his/her jurisdiction or control which, in his/her judgment, is of no further use to the county, he/she may, with the consent of the Board of County Commissioners, have the property declared as surplus and dispose of the property through sale or other means; and

WHEREAS, *Idaho Code* 31-808 provides that property classified as being under \$250.00 may be sold through a private sale without notice of public auction; and

WHEREAS, the Kootenai County Buildings & Grounds Department has on its asset list one (1) 2003 Dodge Dakota Pickup, Asset tag #3828, VIN #1D7GG16X73S219007 which has outlived its usefulness to the department; and

WHEREAS, the equipment described hereinabove is in poor condition, and of no further use to the County. It has been offered to other County departments pursuant to the Excess Personal Property Policy; and

WHEREAS, Kootenai County Buildings & Grounds desires to have the above referenced item declared as surplus property and disposed of pursuant to law;

NOW THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED that the item referenced herein above be, and hereby is declared to be surplus property, and in accordance therewith, the Board of County Commissioners may take action to dispose of said item by public or private sale, or by another means, in accordance with Idaho law and remove the same from the County's list of assets.
