

Resolution 2017-70
Destruction of Records/Kootenai County Sheriff's Office

WHEREAS, *Idaho Code* §31-871 states that county records may only be destroyed by resolution of the Board of County Commissioners; and

WHEREAS, *Idaho Code* §31-871 requires the resolution ordering destruction and disposition of county records to list, in detail, records to be destroyed; and

WHEREAS, an audit of certain county records in the possession of the Kootenai County Sheriff's Office have been performed and legal advice having been sought and given regarding the disposal of said records;

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED that the records of the Kootenai County Sheriff's Office have surpassed the statutory retention period as public records and therefore may be destroyed.

BE IT HEREBY FURTHER RESOLVED that the destruction and disposition of the records identified in Resolution 2017-69 shall be done under the direction and supervision of the Kootenai County Sheriff.
