

Resolution 2017-100
Destroy Records/Parks and Waterways

WHEREAS, section 31-871, *Idaho Code* provides for the classification of records as permanent, semi-permanent, or temporary and destruction thereof; and

WHEREAS, section 31-871, *Idaho Code* requires the Resolution ordering destruction and disposition of county records to list, in detail, records to be destroyed; and

WHEREAS, an audit of certain records of the Parks and Waterways Department was performed, and legal advice having been sought and given, regarding the disposal of certain records; and

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED that certain records of the Parks and Waterways Department, specifically identified in Resolution 2017-99 and Exhibit “A” thereto, have surpassed the statutory retention period for public records of this nature, and therefore may be destroyed.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the destruction and disposition of the original records referenced hereinabove be done under the direction and supervision of the Director of the Parks and Waterways Department.
