**Priority 1. Additional law enforcement funding for two Seasonal Marine Deputies to enforce the rules that are already in place on the Spokane River from General Fund Dollars.**(**MOTION AMENDED-SEE BELOW**)

**Priority 2. Mandatory Boater Education for moving violations (similar to traffic school).**

**Priority 3. Funding for Public Education and Awareness Campaigns “Watch your Wake”.**

The motion was seconded; all were in favor; the motion carried.

More discussion ensued.

**MOTION:** Mike Pelissero moved to amend the first recommendation from Seasonal to Full-time Marine Deputies. The motion was seconded; all were in favor; the motion carried.
