


KOOTENAI COUNTY SOLID WASTE DEPARTMENT
Direct Landfill Discharge Policy

This Department Policy governing the disposal of solid waste is promulgated under the authority of Title 4, Chapter 3 Kootenai County Code as it exists or may subsequently be amended and is effective on May 1, 2013.


Director, Solid Waste Department

The Fighting Creek Landfill facility is not open to the general public for disposal of materials, with the exception of the disposal of large dead animals and asbestos.

Direct landfill discharge for garbage hauling companies is made by exemption by the director of the solid waste department. This is a courtesy and restricted to only those authorized by the Solid Waste Director. This authorization allows for the direct discharge of materials at the Fighting Creek Landfill location either by weighing at a Transfer Station or without weighing the material at a transfer station at the sole discretion of the Kootenai County Solid Waste Department.

Upon arrival at the Fighting Creek Landfill, a county representative is **required** to fill out the appropriate paperwork and estimate the amount of material being discharged at the landfill. The paperwork should be completed and legible and then signed by the driver and the county representative.

The discharge paperwork shall be submitted to the administrative office on a **weekly** basis from the landfill site. Failure to follow the direct landfill policy is a performance issue, which may result in disciplinary action up to and including termination.
