

**Minutes of Meeting**  
**Requests for Cancellation of Taxes**  
**May 6, 2020**  
**9:30 a.m.**

The Kootenai County Board of Commissioners: Chairman Chris Fillios, Commissioner Leslie Duncan and Commissioner Bill Brooks met to discuss the following agenda item. Also present were Chief Deputy Assessor Joe Johns, Chief Deputy Treasurer Laurie Thomas, Civil Deputy Prosecuting Attorney R. David Ferguson, BOCC Administrative Secretary Teri Johnston and Deputy Clerk Tina Ginorio.

- A. Call to Order:** Chairman Chris Fillios called the meeting to order at 9:31 a.m.
- B. Changes to the Agenda (Action):** There were no changes to the agenda.
- C. Action Items:**

**Request for Property Tax Due Date Extension/AIN Nos. 109323; 135604 Post Falls Hotels, Inc.**

Chief Deputy Treasurer Laurie Thomas reported that she had received a phone call and an email from the owners of these two parcels asking for an extension of the June 20, 2020 due date of their taxes.

Commissioner Leslie Duncan stated that, since the taxes were not yet due, they could not be cancelled. She suggested that they follow the existing procedures and apply for relief after the due date, including requesting a Hardship Hearing if appropriate. She asked whether the Hardship application forms should be updated to make them more applicable to businesses' needs.

Ms. Thomas stated that the forms were already formatted to serve both individuals and businesses.

There was general agreement that Commissioner Duncan's suggestion was appropriate.

Commissioner Leslie Duncan moved that the Board deny the request for property tax due date extension for AINs No. 109323 and 135604, with the understanding that the owners can file Hardship applications after June 20, 2020. Commissioner Bill Brooks seconded the motion. There being no further discussion, Deputy Clerk Ginorio called the roll:
