

**Minutes of Meeting  
Juvenile Probation  
May 7, 2018  
8:30 a.m.**

The Kootenai County Board of Commissioners: Chairman Pro Tem Chris Fillios and Commissioner Bob Bingham met to discuss the following agenda item. Also present were Juvenile Probation Director Debra Nadeau and Deputy Clerk Tina Ginorio. Chairman Marc Eberlein was excused.

- A. Call to Order:** Chairman Pro Tem Chris Fillios called the meeting to order at 8:39 a.m.
- B. Changes to the Agenda:** There were no changes to the agenda.

**Juvenile Probation Fleet Vehicle Discussion**

Juvenile Probation Director Debra Nadeau provided the Board with a spreadsheet that listed details of the vehicles used by her department. She reported that one vehicle, a 1998 Ford Club Wagon was in poor condition and behaving unreliably. Ms. Nadeau explained that new parts are no longer manufactured for this vehicle and replacement parts are hard to find and very expensive. She said this van was primarily used to carry Post Falls students in the Alternative to Suspension Program to various community service locations and its unreliability has affected the students' ability to participate in the program. She stated she feels the van needs to be replaced.

Commissioner Bob Bingham inquired whether this item was covered under her department's Budget. Ms. Nadeau said it was not, because the breakdown was not foreseen. She pointed out that there was \$98,000 remaining in the Lottery Windfall account from which such expenses are typically covered. She said this would be more than enough to cover replacing this van and funding the other projects planned previously.

Commissioner Bingham moved that the Board encourage Juvenile Probation Director Debra Nadeau to seek further information on the acquisition of transit van to replace the one suffering from safety and parts issues. Chairman Pro Tem Fillios seconded the motion. There being no further discussion, Deputy Clerk Ginorio called the roll:
