

Minutes of Meeting
Canvass Results for May Elections
May 29, 2019
9:00 a.m.

The Kootenai County Board of Commissioners: Chairman Chris Fillios, Commissioner Leslie Duncan and Commissioner Bill Brooks met to discuss the following agenda item. Also present were Chief Deputy Clerk Jennifer Locke, Elections Manager Judd Wilson, Civil Deputy Prosecutor R. David Ferguson and Deputy Clerk Ronnie Davisson.

- A. Call to Order:** Chairman Chris Fillios called the meeting to order at 9:01 a.m.
- B. Changes to the Agenda (Action):** There were no changes to the agenda.
- C. Business:**

Canvass for May 21, 2019 Consolidated Election – Pursuant to Idaho Code § 34-1205 (Action)

Elections Manager Judd Wilson presented the Canvass to the Board and explained that for it being an odd-year election, there was a good turnout of approximately 7.52%, equating to roughly 6,175 votes cast. Further, there were 292 people who utilized Early voting and 1,715 voted Absentee. He also pointed out that Bayview had the highest turnout. He explained that there was a tie in the Kootenai County Water District and a coin toss was scheduled for the following morning to determine the winner of the race.

Commissioner Leslie Duncan moved to accept the results and Canvass for the May 21, 2019 Election. Commissioner Bill Brooks seconded the motion. There being no further discussion, Deputy Clerk Davisson called the roll:

The motion carried.
