

Community Development Update
Minutes of Meeting
June 11, 2020, 9:00 a.m.

The Kootenai County Board of Commissioners met to discuss Community Development updates. Chair Fillios, Commissioner Duncan, and Commissioner Brooks were present. In attendance were Director David Callahan and Deputy Clerk Sandi Gilbertson. Civil Deputy Prosecuting Attorney Pat Braden participated via teleconference. Valerie Swanson, GIS Analyst, also attended the meeting.

I. Call to Order: Chair Fillios called the meeting to order at 9:07 a.m.

II. Changes to the Agenda: None

III. Business

- A. Addressing continuity for future continuation of Killdeer Lane (county) vs. Killdeer Avenue (city). GIS and the City of Post Falls recommend approval to go with Killdeer Avenue for both portions of the road. A current resident is adamantly opposed to the change. (Action Item)

Director Callahan said this is an informational item for the Board. He added that the department has the responsibility of implementing, enforcing and maintaining the addressing and road naming standards and that no road shall have more than one name. GIS and the City of Post Falls recommend approval to go with Killdeer Avenue for both portions of the road.
