

**Minutes of Meeting
Community Development Update
September 17, 2018, 1:30 p.m.**

The Kootenai County Board of Commissioners met to discuss Community Development updates. Commissioner Fillios and Commissioner Bingham were present. Chairman Eberlein was excused. In attendance were Community Development Director David Callahan and Deputy Clerk Sandi Gilbertson.

A. Call to Order: Chairman pro-tem Fillios called the meeting to order at 1:36 p.m.

B. Changes to the Agenda: No changes.

C. Business

1. Determination to allow rock hauling to continue on an expired conditional use permit. (Action)

Director Callahan explained that Coeur d'Alene Paving had a conditional use permit for this site but the permit expired a year ago. There is a hearing before the Hearing Examiner on October 4, 2018 to restore a conditional use permit. Director Callahan explained that there has been hauling off the site but there have been no complaints. His determination was that he decided not to put a stop work violation because there have been no complaints and because of the upcoming hearing. Both Commissions agreed that they are both in support of the Director's decision and the hauling can continue.

Public Comment: This section is reserved for citizens wishing to address the Board regarding a County related issue. Idaho Law prohibits Board action on items brought under this section except in an emergency circumstance. Comments related to future public hearings should be held for that public hearing.

There being no further discussion of the agenda items or public comment, Chairman pro-tem Fillios adjourned the meeting at 1:43 p.m.
