

**Minutes of Meeting
Juvenile Probation
November 5, 2018
8:30 a.m.**

The Kootenai County Board of Commissioners: Chairman Marc Eberlein, Commissioner Chris Fillios, and Commissioner Bob Bingham met to discuss the following agenda item. Also present were Juvenile Probation Director Deb Nadeau and Deputy Clerk Ronnie Davisson. Also present was Idaho Department of Juvenile Corrections District 1 & 2 Liaison Zlata Myr.

- A. Call to Order:** Chairman Marc Eberlein called the meeting to order at 8:33 a.m.
- B. Changes to the Agenda:** There were no changes to the agenda.
- C. Business:**

New Idaho Department of Juvenile Corrections District 1 & 2 Liaison (Action)

Juvenile Probation Director Deb Nadeau introduced Zlata Myr, the new Idaho Department of Juvenile Corrections District 1 & 2 Liaison. She explained that the former liaison, Jim Crowley, had retired and Ms. Myr had taken over the position. Further, Ms. Myr had worked for Kootenai County Juvenile Probation for ten years.

Kootenai County Annual Juvenile Justice Report (Action)

Ms. Nadeau explained the Annual Juvenile Justice Report was due November 15 and the financials were due December 1. She pointed out that the juvenile statistics were down, not only locally, but also nationally. Further, the recidivism rate was 19% for Idaho, which was below the national average of 30-35%.

Commissioner Chris Fillios moved to approve the Annual Juvenile Justice Report. Commissioner Bob Bingham seconded the motion. There being no further discussion, Deputy Clerk Davisson called the roll:

Chairman Eberlein: Aye

The motion carried.

Juvenile Chaplain/Outreach – Advocacy Independent Contract Changes (Discussion)

Ms. Nadeau said the current chaplain, Jeff Cheeseborough, was in a state of declining health and would be searching for his replacement. Mr. Cheeseborough recommended Diego Rodriguez to share in the contract with him until a permanent replacement could be found. She said Mr. Rodriguez would work 8 hours a week, while Mr. Cheeseborough would work 7 hours.

City Parking Garage Construction Update (Discussion)

Ms. Nadeau provided a brief update on the parking garage currently under construction. She said the construction was nearly completed and was anticipating a December 1 open date. Ms. Nadeau also said that the City of Coeur d’Alene was amenable to keeping the monthly parking fee at \$15 for Juvenile Probation and would provide 35 spots. Further, the only contract change was that it would be with City of Coeur d’Alene, not Diamond Parking.

D. Public Comment: This section is reserved for citizens wishing to address the Board regarding a County related issue. Idaho Law prohibits Board action on items brought under this section except in an emergency circumstance. Comments related to future public hearings should be held for that public hearing. There were no public comments.

Chairman Eberlein adjourned the meeting at 8:56 a.m.
