

RESOLUTION 2018-35

MOORAGE OF VESSELS AT COUNTY FACILITIES AND NOISE RESTRICTION

WHEREAS, Section 67-7031(3), Idaho Code, authorizes the boards of county commissioners of each county in Idaho to adopt local ordinances with reference to the operation of vessels on any waters within its territorial limits, provided said ordinances are intended to promote or protect the health, safety, and general welfare of its citizenry; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 31-807, Idaho Code, it is the responsibility of the Kootenai County Board of Commissioners to manage the use of facilities owned by Kootenai County, which provide access to waterways and recreational opportunities; and

WHEREAS, the Kootenai County Board of Commissioners has adopted the *Kootenai County Parks and Waterways Ordinance*, Kootenai County Code, Section 6-2-1, *et seq.*; and

WHEREAS, the *Kootenai County Parks and Waterways Ordinance* provides the authority for the Board of Commissioners to adopt by resolution reasonable rules governing the conduct of persons utilizing County-owned and/or County-managed facilities, Kootenai County Code, Section 6-2-16(A); and

WHEREAS, the *Kootenai County Parks and Waterways Ordinance* provides the authority for the Board to remove from any County-owned and/or County-managed facility any person who violates the Idaho Code, the *Kootenai County Parks and Waterways Ordinance*, and/or any resolution, rule, regulation, term, or condition promulgates pursuant to the provisions of the Ordinance pursuant to Kootenai County Code, Section 6-2-14(A); and

WHEREAS, the Director of the Kootenai County Parks and Waterways Department has recommended that the practice of rafting any vessels to one another when said vessels are moored to a dock be prohibited at County-owned and/or County-managed facilities; and

WHEREAS, the Kootenai County Sheriff and the Director of the Kootenai County Parks and Waterways Department have recommended implementing quiet hours at County-owned and/or County-managed facilities between the hours of 10 p.m. and 8 a.m., such that noise levels shall not be audible more than 100 feet from the sound origination point and/or the ordinary high water mark, as that term is defined in Section 58-1302, Idaho Code; and;

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners concurs with the recommendations of the Kootenai County Sheriff and the Director of the Kootenai County Parks and Waterways Department.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED that the restrictions identified hereinabove shall become effective upon sufficient public notice and posting of the rules and penalties for violations thereof as required by Section 67-7031(3), Idaho Code, and Section 6-2-16(B), Kootenai County Code.

Upon motion to adopt the text of the foregoing Resolution made by Commissioner Fillios and seconded by Commissioner Bingham, the following vote was recorded:





Notice of Public Hearing

The Kootenai County Board of Commissioners will conduct a Public Hearing for the purpose of receiving public comment on the following:

Proposed Resolution 2018-35 applies to County-owned and/or County-managed facilities and would prohibit the practice of rafting vessels to one another when said vessels are moored to a County dock and restrict noise levels at County facilities between the hours of 10:00 p.m. and 8:00 a.m., such that noise levels are not audible more than 100 feet from the sound origination point and/or the ordinary high water mark.

The Board of County Commissioners will conduct a public hearing for the purpose of hearing public comment on this matter at 2:00 p.m. on Tuesday, August 21, 2018 in the Commissioners Board Room, located on the Third Floor of the County Administration Building, 451 N. 
