City Link Will Maintain Service

PLUMMER, Idaho— City Link has no plans to suspend service at this time, despite COVID-19 (coronavirus) concerns continuing across the nation and in our community. We are taking aggressive measures to protect the sanitation of our transportation system so that we can continue to provide this essential service while mitigating the public risk of exposure to the virus.

City Link has ordered additional hand sanitizer, wipes and disinfectant for the drivers to use on the buses to help reduce the risk, beyond current inventory levels. Each of the drivers will have the responsibility of wiping down all surfaces inside the vehicle between each run while they are waiting to depart on the next run. When the buses are brought in for service, they are washed down inside and out by our drivers that are on extended breaks during the day.

We are also closely monitoring the health of our drivers and requiring any driver exhibiting symptoms of sickness to remain home. We strongly encourage the same for our passengers, and advise everyone to practice social distancing and hand washing per CDC guidelines to protect our community from viral transmission. Please do not use the public transit system if you are experiencing symptoms of illness.

We will continue working to keep a clean, comfortable environment to provide the community with transportation needs in the light of this health crisis. Since the COVID-19 situation is unfolding very quickly, we will continue to update policies as necessary to protect the safety of our drivers, our passengers, and our community.
