



May 19th Primary Voting Information

There are many questions about the recent changes affecting the May 19th Idaho Primary Election, including:

1. I'm not registered right now but want to vote in May. Can I still register to vote?
Absolutely! You can register online at IdahoVotes.gov - <https://idahovotes.gov/>
You will need an Idaho Drivers' License or ID Card – Registration deadline 8:00 p.m. on 5/19/2020
2. Will there be ANY option to vote in person? How can I get an absentee ballot to vote by mail?
There will not be any in-person voting for the May 19th primary election. You must vote by mail. You can obtain an absentee ballot request form at IdahoVotes.gov. <https://idahovotes.gov/>
3. When can I request a ballot? When I can mail it back in?
You can request a ballot from now until 8:00 p.m. on May 19, 2020. Completed ballots will be accepted from now until 8:00 p.m. on June 2, 2020. We highly encourage voters to request their ballot as soon as possible in order to ensure you have sufficient time for your request to be processed, for your ballot to be mailed to you, and for you to return it before the deadline.
4. If I'm registered to vote, do I need to request a ballot or will one be sent to me automatically?
All voters must request a ballot in order to vote. Ballots will not be sent automatically. You can check your registration status and find out if you have already requested a ballot at IdahoVotes.gov.
5. I don't have internet access. How can I request a ballot?
Ballot request forms will be mailed to all registered voters who have not yet sent in a request for the May election; however, if you do not have internet access, have any questions about the May election, or have accessibility concerns, please call your local Elections Office at (208) 446-1030 or email kcelections@kcgov.us.
