

RESOLUTION NO. 2009-52

(Classify Property/Office Furniture/Kootenai County Sheriff's Department)

WHEREAS, Idaho Code §31-807 vests the Board of County Commissioners with the power and authority to manage real and personal property for the benefit of the County; and

WHEREAS, Idaho Code § 31-808 provides that a Board of County Commissioners shall have the power and authority to sell or offer for sale at public auction any real or personal property no longer necessary to its use.

WHEREAS, Idaho Code § 31-808 also states that property classified as being valued under \$250.00 may be sold at a private sale without notice of public auction.

WHEREAS, the Kootenai County Sheriff's Department was the title owner of several pieces of personal property for used in various administration divisions of the Sheriff's Department. The personal property is identified as follows:
