

RESOLUTION NO. 2009-53

(Surplus Courtshell Property/Kootenai County Sheriff's Department)

WHEREAS, Idaho Code §31-807 vests the Board of County Commissioners with the power and authority to manage real and personal property for the benefit of the County; and

WHEREAS, Idaho Code §31-829 provides that whenever any elected official has any personal property belonging to the county under his/her jurisdiction or control which, in his/her judgment, is of no further use to the county, he/she may, with the consent of the Board of County Commissioners, have the property declared as surplus and dispose of the property through sale or other means;

WHEREAS, the Kootenai County Sheriff's Department is the owner of several pieces of personal property which were used for various administrative functions throughout the Sheriff's Department, or was abandoned by inmates at the County Jail. The personal property is identified as follows:
