

Resolution 2009-46

(Authorization to Destroy Records of the Kootenai County Sheriff's Department)

WHEREAS, *Idaho Code* §31-871 states that County records may only be destroyed by resolution of the Board of County Commissioners; and,

WHEREAS, an audit of certain County records has been performed and legal advise regarding the disposal of these records has been received; and,

WHEREAS, *Idaho Code* §31-871 requires the resolution ordering destruction and disposition of County records to list, in detail, records to be destroyed; and,

WHEREAS, these records contain protected health information of Kootenai County Jail inmates that are no longer in custody and have not been in custody for seven (7) years or longer.

NOW THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED that the records of the Kootenai County Sheriff's Department incorporated by reference herein are authorized to be destroyed.

BE IT HEREBY FURTHER RESOLVED that the destruction and disposition of the records shall be under the direction and supervision of the Clerk of the Kootenai County Board of Commissioners.
