

Resolution 2009-100
Adjust 2009 Taxes to Reflect Circuit Breaker
Parcel No. A6999013999B/AIN 113711/Radenz

WHEREAS, the Kootenai County Board of Commissioners has received a request for adjustment of the 2009 property taxes on the above stated parcel record owner being Lorraine Radenz, 5875 E. Bennet Ave (PO Box 836), Athol, ID 83801; and,

WHEREAS, the application for Circuit Breaker was pre-printed and listed the parcel number for Lorraine's previous address (same PO Box), and as a result the exemption was not placed on Lorraine's new parcel; and,

WHEREAS, it is too late to apply the reduction to the new parcel, but Lorraine's daughter, who jointly owns and resides in the previous home, has agreed to apply the reduction she received to the new parcel. The difference in the value of the homes leaves a discrepancy in the amount of \$92.85; and,

WHEREAS, the Assessor's office has made a recommendation to the Board of Commissioners to reduce the taxes on the new parcel in the amount of \$92.85 to correct the disparity.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED that the 2009 taxes be reduced by \$92.85.

IT IS FURTHER RESOLVED that the Treasurer and Auditor be directed to take appropriate action to effectuate said resolution.
