

Resolution 2010-108
Transfer Property/County Deed
City of Post Falls

WHEREAS, *Idaho Code* §67-2322 and §67-2323 authorize the transfer of property by a local unit of government to another governmental body; and

WHEREAS, the County of Kootenai has deed to a certain parcel of real property which it is willing to transfer to the taxing district with jurisdiction; and

WHEREAS, the County of Kootenai has determined that the transfer of real property to the taxing district with jurisdiction which is the City of Post Falls, is in the best interest of the public; and

WHEREAS, the transfer of the property will be made without consideration.

NOW THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED that conveyance or transfer of the real property listed below without consideration will occur upon execution of written agreement between the units of government or taxing entity after a Notice of Intended Transfer of Property has been published per Idaho Code.

Lot 00A, Block 2, BAY STREET PLAZA, according to the plat filed in Book "G" of Plats, Page 175 & 175a, records of Kootenai County, Idaho.
