

**Resolution 2013-111
Destroy Records/KCSO**

WHEREAS, *Idaho Code* §31-871 states that county records may only be destroyed by resolution of the Board of County Commissioners; and

WHEREAS, an audit of certain county records maintained by the Kootenai County Sheriff's Department has been performed and legal advice regarding the disposal of these records has been received; and,

WHEREAS, *Idaho Code* §31-871 requires the resolution ordering destruction and disposition of county records to list, in detail, records to be destroyed;

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED that the terminated employee records of the Kootenai County Sheriff's Department as described in Resolution 2013-110 adopted on December 30, 2013 are authorized to be destroyed; further that the destruction of said records be accomplished under the direction of the Kootenai County Sheriff.
