

Vehicle Registration Frequently Asked Questions



1. USING QLESS

A. Choose the right office for your needs.

- Kootenai County DMV (CDA or Post Falls) for vehicle titles, plates, new car registrations & transfers (either titling/registration option can be used to schedule)
- Drivers' License (CDA or Post Falls) for new drivers tests & all other drivers' license needs

B. Appointments can be set up to 45 days in advance only.

All appointments are currently full. If you don't see an available appointment time now, check the app again first thing tomorrow morning when a new day becomes available in the app. (App shows a 60 day calendar but appointments are up to 45 days.)

2. CHECKING VEHICLE TITLE/REGISTRATION STATUS ONLINE

Visit the Idaho Transportation Department (ITD) website at <https://itd.idaho.gov/itddmv/> to:

- * Renew your vehicle registration/license plates
- * Get registration information
- * Check insurance requirements
- * Order personalized plates
- * Check status of your plates/renewal
