County Announces Swearing-in of Newly Elected Officials

January 7, 2021 – Kootenai County will hold a brief ceremony next week to swear-in all newly-elected and incumbent county officials. The event will begin at 10:00 a.m. on Monday, January 11, 2021, in the county administration building (451 Government Way, Coeur d'Alene).

Commissioner Leslie Duncan will give a statement of welcome, followed by the Presentation of Colors by the KCSO Honor Guard and an invocation by Pastor Eddie Bateman. County Clerk Jim Brannon will then swear in:

- Commissioner Bill Brooks (Commissioner District 1), who has served in his position for two years and was re-elected to serve an additional four-year term;
- Commissioner Chris Fillios (Commissioner District 2), who has served in his position for four years and was re-elected to serve an additional two-year term;
- Prosecutor Barry McHugh, who has served in his position for twelve years and was re-elected to serve another four-year term; and
- Sheriff Bob Norris, who will be serving his first (four-year) term as county sheriff.
