RESCINDING OF ORDER FOR
MANDATORY SAFETY PROTOCOLS IN
THE BENEWAH COUNTY COURTHOUSE.**

**ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER
H21-DW.17**

Rich Christensen, Administrative District Judge of the First Judicial District hereby finds and Orders as follows:

WHEREAS; there was a previous Administrative Order entered pursuant to the Idaho Supreme Court's Emergency Order Regarding Court Services as entered June 24, 2021 requiring all counties that had a seven-day moving average incident rate of confirmed presumed cases of COVID-19 of 25.0 or greater to require certain safety protocols requiring all person entering such county courthouses to do court business to wear a mask and maintain six feet of social distance from anyone not living in their household, and;

WHEREAS, such an Emergency Order was entered on June 25, 2021 requiring Benewah County to maintain such safety protocols, and;

WHEREAS, the seven-day moving average incident rate for Benewah County was listed as 1.5 per 100,000 population as reflected on the Cases by County page of the Idaho Department of Health and Welfare's COVID-19 Data Dashboard for the day ending June 30, 2021,

NOW THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED, that sections 2 and 3 on page 2 of the Order Re: Postponement of Jury Trials And Mandatory Safety Protocols In The Benewah County Courthouse are RESCINDED.
