

**Resolution 2022-76**  
**Surplus Property and Asset Deletion/Assessor**

**WHEREAS**, *Idaho Code* §31-807 vests the Board of County Commissioners with the power and authority to manage real and personal property for the benefit of the County, and

**WHEREAS**, *Idaho Code* §31-829 provides that whenever any elected official has any personal property belonging to the county under his/her jurisdiction or control which, in his/her judgment, is of no further use to the county, he/she may, with the consent of the Board of County Commissioner, have the property declared as surplus and dispose of the property through sale or other means; and

**WHEREAS**, *Idaho Code* §31-808 provides that property not exceeding \$250.00 in value may be sold through a private sale without notice of public auction; and

**WHEREAS**, the Kootenai County Assessor's office has on its Asset List one (1) Ricoh MP4001Sp Copier, Asset # 6093; one (1) Designcrafts Bench, Asset #06148 and one (1) ArcInfo Concurrent Use Upgrade ESRI Software, Asset #S200 which are obsolete due to age, inoperable and not repairable, and/or are fully depreciated, and have therefore outlived their useful life and are of no further use to the County; and

**WHEREAS**, the estimated total value of the equipment is less than \$250.00; and

**WHEREAS**, the Kootenai County Assessor's Office desires to have the items referenced hereinabove declared surplus property, disposed of pursuant to law, and/or removed from the County's asset list;

**NOW THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED** that the items referenced in Exhibit "A" be, and hereby are, declared to be surplus property, and in accordance therewith, the Board of County Commissioners may take action to dispose of said items in accordance with Idaho law, and remove the same from the County's list of assets.


