

RESOLUTION NO. 2022-62

**DONATION OF EQUIPMENT TO KOOTENAI COUNTY FAIRGROUNDS/
BUILDINGS & GROUNDS**

WHEREAS, *Idaho Code* §31-807 vests the Board of County Commissioners with the power and authority to manage real and personal property for the benefit of the County; and

WHEREAS, *Idaho Code* §31-829 provides that whenever any elected official has any personal property belonging to the county under his/her jurisdiction or control which, in his/her judgment, is of no further use to the county, he/she may, with the consent of the Board of County Commissioners, have the property declared as surplus and dispose of the property through sale or other means; and

WHEREAS, *Idaho Code* §31-808 provides that the board of county commissioners may, at its discretion, grant to or exchange with any political subdivision, with or without compensation, any property owned by the county, after adoption of a resolution by the board of county commissioners that the grant or exchange of property is in the public interest; and,

WHEREAS, the Kootenai County Buildings & Grounds Department has in its possession the following:

WHEREAS, the property/equipment hereinabove referenced are in good condition, but do not meet the needs of the department; and

WHEREAS, the property/equipment referenced hereinabove is presently listed on Kootenai County's asset list which is maintained by the Kootenai County Auditor's Office. It is the desire of the Buildings & Grounds department to have the property/equipment referenced hereinabove declared as surplus property and then donated to the Kootenai County Fairgrounds; and,

NOW THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED that the property/equipment described hereinabove be, and hereby is, declared to be surplus property, and in accordance therewith, the Board of County Commissioners may take action to dispose of said property in accordance with Idaho law.



IT IS FURTHER RESOLVED that the Board of County Commissioners consents to the donation of the property/equipment described hereinabove to the Kootenai County Fairgrounds and hereby authorizes the Kootenai County Auditor to remove the property/equipment from Kootenai County's list of assets.
