

Resolution 2022-27
Surplus Equipment/Asset Deletion/Solid Waste

WHEREAS, *Idaho Code* §31-807 vests the Board of County Commissioners with the power and authority to manage real and personal property for the benefit of the County; and

WHEREAS, *Idaho Code* §31-829 provides that whenever any elected official has any personal property belonging to the county under his/her jurisdiction or control which, in his/her judgment, is of no further use to the County, he/she may, with the consent of the Board of County Commissioners, have the property declared as surplus and dispose of the property through sale or other means; and

WHEREAS, the Kootenai County Solid Waste Department has on its list of assets one (1) 2008 Reliance Transfer Trailer, Mosel ATSLT-48-3, Asset #126, License #A12412, Serial #5RESZ03868S082015 which is has been involved in a traffic accident and totaled in exchange for an insurance settlement; and

WHEREAS, the Kootenai County Solid Waste Department desires to have the above-referenced property declared as surplus, disposed of pursuant to law, and removed from the County's asset list;

NOW THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED that the item referenced hereinabove be, and hereby is, declared to be surplus property, and in accordance therewith, the Board of County Commissioners may take action to dispose of said items in accordance with Idaho law and remove the same from the County's list of assets.




