

**RESOLUTION NO. 2022-18**

**In the Matter of Establishing Election Precincts as Required by  
Idaho Code § 34-301**

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners is required by Idaho Code § 34-301 to establish a convenient number of election precincts; and,

WHEREAS, the number of registered voters in certain precincts had increased to such size that the administration of elections was negatively affected; and,

WHEREAS, Legislative redistricting was recently accomplished by the State of Idaho resulting in the need to redraw precincts to conform to Idaho Code sections 34-301 and 34-306.

NOW THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED that the Kootenai County election precincts be established as shown on the attached maps and numbered as follows:

Legislative District #2 – 201, 202, 203, 204, 205, 206, 207, 208

Legislative District #3 – 301, 302, 303, 304, 305, 306, 307, 308, 309, 310, 311, 312, 313, 314, 315, 316, 317, 318, 319, 320, 321, 322, 323

Legislative District #4 - 401, 402, 403, 404, 405, 406, 407, 408, 409, 410, 411, 412, 413, 414, 415, 416, 417, 418, 419, 420

Legislative District #5 - 501, 502, 503, 504, 505, 506, 507, 508, 509, 510, 511, 512, 513, 514, 515, 516, 517, 518, 519, 520, 521, 522

The newly adopted precincts shall be adopted this day, but not take effect until March 18, 2022, to allow the March 8, 2022 school levy elections to utilize existing precinct numbering and boundaries;

Further, the newly adopted precincts, though not effective until March 18, 2022, shall be utilized from February 28, 2022 through March 11, 2022, for purposes of declaring candidacy for any offices that are affected by residency within or without a certain precinct; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Kootenai County Clerk and Auditor is hereby authorized to commence with all necessary speed to implement the changes necessary to effectuate the implementation of this resolution, including but not limited to beginning the data conversion process for any and all precincts not affected by the March 8, 2022 school levy elections.

Upon a motion to adopt the text of the foregoing Resolution made by Commissioner Duncan, seconded by Commissioner Brooks, the following vote was recorded:






