

**Resolution 2022-02
Destroy Records/Parks & Waterways**

WHEREAS, *Idaho Code* §31-871 provides for the classification of records as permanent, semi-permanent, or temporary and destruction thereof; and

WHEREAS, *Idaho Code* §31-871 requires the Resolution ordering the destruction and disposition of county records to list, in detail, records to be destroyed; and

WHEREAS, an audit of certain records of the Parks and Waterways Department was performed, and legal advice having been sought and given regarding the disposal of certain records;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED that certain records of the Parks and Waterways Department, specifically identified in Resolution 2022-01 and Exhibit "A" thereto, have been classified as temporary and have surpassed the statutory retention period for public records of this nature, and therefore may be destroyed.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the destruction and disposition of the original records identified in Exhibit "A" to Resolution 2022-01 be done under the direction and supervision of the Director of the Parks & Waterways Department.

Upon a motion to adopt the text of the foregoing Resolution made by Commissioner Duncan, seconded by Commissioner Brooks, the following vote was recorded:


