NOW THEREFORE, IT IS RESOLVED that the taxes for the 2021 tax year be adjusted to reflect a circuit breaker in the amount of up to \$910.00; and


BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Treasurer and Assessor be directed to take appropriate action to effectuate said resolution.

Upon a motion to adopt the text of the foregoing Resolution made by Commissioner Duncan, seconded by Commissioner Fillios, the following vote was recorded:


