WHEREAS, the Kootenai County Board of Commissioners received a request for reduction of the 2021 taxes on the above referenced parcel number, record owner being Beverly Townsend, 718 E. Anchor Way, Post Falls, Idaho 83854; and

WHEREAS, Ms. Townsend requested the adjustment of the 2021 taxes to reflect a casualty loss on the property due to severe wind damage to the home during a storm in January 2021, culminating in the demolition of the home; and

WHEREAS, the Kootenai County Board of Commissioners, on August 3, 2022 at a properly noticed meeting, agreed to a decrease in value from \$987,524 to \$890,983 to be reflected in a refund on the property taxes due December 20, 2021;

NOW THEREFORE, IT IS RESOLVED that the taxes for the 2021 tax year be adjusted to reflect a decrease in value; and


BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Treasurer and Auditor be directed to take appropriate action to effectuate said resolution.



NOW THEREFORE, IT IS RESOLVED that the taxes for the 2021 tax year be adjusted to reflect a decrease in value; and


BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Treasurer and Auditor be directed to take appropriate action to effectuate said resolution.





