**NOW THEREFORE, IT IS RESOLVED** that the taxes for the 2022 year be adjusted to include a 70% VA Exemption, and


**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that the Treasurer and Assessor be directed to take appropriate action to effectuate said Resolution.


Upon a motion to adopt the text of the foregoing Resolution made by Commissioner Brooks, seconded by Commissioner Fillios, the following vote was recorded:




