Adjust Taxes to Reflect Casualty Loss

WHEREAS, the Kootenai County Board of Commissioners received a request for reduction of the 2022 taxes on the above referenced parcel number, record owner being Katherine M. Porter, 400 Woodside Ave., Post Falls, Idaho 83854; and

WHEREAS, Ms. Porter requested the adjustment of the 2022 taxes to reflect a casualty loss on the property due to severe wind damage to the home during a storm in November, 2022; and

WHEREAS, the Kootenai County Board of Commissioners, on December 7, 2022 at a properly noticed meeting, agreed to a decrease taxes from \$3,229.25 to \$3,103.12 to be applied to the property taxes due December 20, 2022;

NOW THEREFORE, IT IS RESOLVED that the taxes for the 2022 tax year be adjusted to reflect a decrease in value; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Treasurer and Auditor be directed to take appropriate action to effectuate said resolution.

Upon a motion to adopt the text of the foregoing Resolution made by Commissioner Fillios, seconded by Commissioner Brooks, the following vote was recorded:






