

**Resolution 2022-34**  
**Surplus Property and Asset Deletion/Parks and Waterways**

**WHEREAS**, *Idaho Code* §31-807 vests the Board of County Commissioners with the power and authority to manage real and personal property for the benefit of the County, and

**WHEREAS**, *Idaho Code* §31-829 provides that whenever any elected official has any personal property belonging to the county under his/her jurisdiction or control which, in his/her judgment, is of no further use to the county, he/she may, with the consent of the Board of County Commissioner, have the property declared as surplus and dispose of the property through sale or other means; and

**WHEREAS**, *Idaho Code* §31-808 provides that property not exceeding \$250.00 in value may be sold through a private sale without notice of public auction; and

**WHEREAS**, the Kootenai County Parks and Waterways Department has on its Asset List (identified at Exhibit “A” hereto), certain Dock and Pilings, as part of the Windy Bay Dock Project, Asset # P578, Serial Number Public Recreation 04, which are obsolete due to age, inoperable and not repairable, and/or are fully depreciated, and have therefore outlived their useful life and are of no further use to the County; and

**WHEREAS**, certain items listed on Exhibit “A” are not in the possession of the Kootenai County Parks and Waterways Department as said items have been in the possession and under the management of the bureau of Land Management since 2003; and

**WHEREAS**, the Kootenai County Parks and Waterways Department desires to have the items listed on Exhibit “A” declared surplus property, disposed of pursuant to law, and/or removed from the County’s asset list;

**NOW THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED** that the items referenced in Exhibit “A” be, and hereby are, declared to be surplus property, and in accordance therewith, the Board of County Commissioners may take action to dispose of said items in accordance with Idaho law, and remove the same from the County’s list of assets.

Upon a motion to adopt the text of the foregoing Resolution made by Commissioner Brooks, seconded by Commissioner Duncan, the following vote was recorded:


