

RESOLUTION NO. 2022- 106
Obligation of American Rescue Plan Act (ARPA) Funds
Addition to Justice Building

WHEREAS, Kootenai County is a recipient of federal funding through the American Rescue Plan Act (ARPA) State and Local Fiscal Recovery Fund (SLFRF); and

WHEREAS, the SLFRF program is intended to provide support to State, Local, and Tribal Governments (together, recipients) in responding to the impact of COVID-19; and

WHEREAS, Kootenai County's use of funds must be eligible under appropriate United States Treasury regulations, which was the Interim Final Rule between 17 May 2021 and 1 April 2022, and the Final Rule after 1 April 2022; and

WHEREAS, the Justice Building Addition project is an approved expense under Expenditure Category 3.5, Public Sector Capacity and Administrative Needs; and

WHEREAS, the Kootenai County Board of Commissioners has appropriated ARPA funds to complete the Justice Building Addition project; and

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED that the Kootenai County Board of Commissioners hereby obligates ARPA funds in the amount of twenty-six million, three hundred seventy-six thousand, twenty-one dollars (\$26,376,021) for preconstruction and construction expenses, with the expectation that value engineering through the Construction Management/General Contractor project delivery method will reduce costs as much as possible.


