

**Resolution 2022-67**  
**Exchange or Trade of Personal Property**  
**Information Technology**

**WHEREAS**, *Idaho Code* §31-829 provides that whenever any elected official has any personal property belonging to the county under his jurisdiction or control which, in his judgment is obsolete, worn or damaged so as to require replacement and is of greater value on a trade-in or exchange for replacements than upon the sale as above permitted, he may, incident to purchase of such replacements and with the consent of the Board of County Commissioners, trade in or exchange such personal property and apply its trade-in or exchange value on the purchase price of replacements;

**WHEREAS**, Kootenai County Information Technology has in its possession one (1) Designjet T1300ps Printer, Asset # 5648 identified on the Kootenai County Auditor's Asset Data Sheets, a copy of which attached hereto as Exhibit "A" and made a part hereof by reference;

**WHEREAS**, the equipment referenced above is obsolete due to age, and fully depreciated, and therefore outlived its useful life and is of no further use to the County; and

**WHEREAS**, it is the desire of Information Technology to apply the value of the equipment described hereinabove to the purchase of an MFP-TZ30000 MFP Plotter, and;

**WHEREAS**, H & H Equipment, Post Falls, Idaho has offered to take in trade the Designjet T1300ps Printer for a value of \$3,951.00 leaving a balance owed of \$9,999.00; and

**WHEREAS**, the Kootenai County Board of Commissioners consents to the trade in of the equipment described hereinabove;

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED** that Kootenai County Information Technology is hereby authorized to apply the value of the Designjet T1300ps Printer to the cost of an MFP-TZ30000 Plotter offered through H & H Equipment.
