

IN THE DISTRICT COURT OF THE FIRST JUDICIAL DISTRICT OF THE
STATE OF IDAHO

Idaho Code 31-3220 intends the waiver of fees to enable
an indigent to:

1. Commence civil suit;
2. Defend a civil suit;
3. Appeal a civil suit judgment;
4. Have process issued and served; and
5. Subpoena and pay the costs of attendance of
witnesses.

Said section does not authorize or require clerks to supply
copies, either certified or uncertified, of any file in
possession of the clerk. Said section does not require the
Office of Recorder, Auditor, or Clerk of the Board of County
Commissioners to supply any copies of records in those
offices without charge.

Accordingly, insofar as Court records are concerned, the
Clerks of Court will be guided and comply with Idaho Code
31-3201 requiring payment for copies of records.

IT IS SO ORDERED.


