ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER C09-KOO.1

RE: PROBATION AND PAROLE ACCESS TO KOOTENAI COUNTY SEALED RECORDS

WHEREAS, Idaho Administrative Rule 32 addresses the examination, copying and exemption from the limitations on disclosure of judicial department records; and

WHEREAS subsection (c) of Rule 32 provides that this rule shall apply to all court records existing on or after the date of adoption of this Rule. Provided, this Rule shall not prevent access to records, otherwise exempt from disclosure by the following persons in the following situations:

- (1) If approved by the custodian judge, or the custodian in the case of any record in the judicial council, federal, state and local officials or their agent examining a judicial record in the exercise of their official duties and powers; however, requests for numerous records or records from more than one county must be approved by the Chief Justice.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that pursuant to Idaho Court Administrative Rule 32(c)(1), United State Federal Probation and Parole Officers, Idaho State Probation and Parole Officers and Kootenai County Misdemeanor Probation Officers, Kootenai County Juvenile Probation Officers and Kootenai County Juvenile Diversion Officers be given access to sealed records that will assist with case report preparation.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that prior to gaining access to sealed records, the requesting officer will present a valid picture identification and proof of employment with one of the previously listed probation/parole agencies to the Administrative District Judge or his designee.
