**ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER
C25-DW.1**

PROCESSING OF CITATIONS WHICH MAY RESULT IN AN AUTOMATIC DISMISSAL

WHEREAS the types of proceedings listed below are subject to automatic dismissal pursuant to Idaho law given specific conditions stated in the law and

WHEREAS it appears as though it would be appropriate for the Clerks of the District Court to enter said dismissals upon being given appropriate proof of compliance, now therefore;


IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the Clerks of the District Court of the First Judicial District and/or their deputies shall be and are hereby authorized to accept proof of compliance and enter dismissals upon the proper showing of proof by the defendant or another person appearing on behalf of the defendant in the following situations:

- a.) Failure to carry driver's license- Idaho Code §49-316.** If a license is presented that was validly issued to the defendant prior to the issuance of the citation, the Clerk shall photocopy the license, place the copy with the citation, and dismiss the same.
- b.) Failure to carry registration- Idaho Code §49-427.** If a valid registration is presented which has been issued for the vehicle operated by the defendant prior to the issuance of the citation, the Clerk shall photocopy the registration, place the copy with the citation, and dismiss the same.
- c.) Failure to carry proof of insurance- Idaho Code §49-1232.** If a proof of insurance or certificate of insurance is presented covering the vehicle operated by the defendant that was in effect prior to the issuance of the citation, or a copy of the actual insurance policy is presented covering the vehicle operated by the defendant that was in effect prior to the issuance of the citation, the Clerk shall photocopy the proof of insurance, place the copy with the citation, and dismiss the same.

- d.) Failure to carry hunting and fishing license- Idaho Code §36-1201.** Upon presentation of a hunting and/or fishing license that was validly issued to the defendant prior to the issuance of the citation, the Clerk shall photocopy the license, place the copy with the citation, and dismiss the same.
- e.) Failure to have registration certificate and/or vessel number-Idaho Code §67-7008.** If a valid registration is presented which has been issued for the boat operated by the defendant prior to the issuance of the citation, the Clerk shall photocopy the registration, place the copy with the citation, and dismiss the same.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that Administrative Order C95-DW.1 is rescinded.
