ORDER DEFINING METHOD OF PAYMENT



IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that all payments made to the court by coin shall be accepted by court personnel only if the coins are wrapped and identified as follows:

the coins must be in bank coin wrappers for the appropriate denomination of coin with the name, address and phone number of the person tendering the payment written on the outside wrapping of the roll. The requirement that coins be wrapped in rolls and identified shall be effective when the number of coins (or monetary face value thereof) exceeds the following:

pennies	more than 50 cents
nickels	more than 2 dollars
dimes	more than 5 dollars
quarters	more than 10 dollars
half-dollars	more than 20 dollars
