**ORDER APPOINTING LAW ENFORCEMENT OFFICERS TO
RECEIVE CASH BAIL**

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED, that


1. Pursuant to M.C.R. 12(b) the Sheriff and all duly appointed Deputy Sheriffs in the Counties of Boundary, Bonner, Kootenai, Benewah, and Shoshone, State of Idaho, are appointed to receive cash deposits in lieu of bail in criminal actions in accordance with the Bail Schedule and provisions set forth in M.C.R. 13
2. Such officers shall, before receiving any cash deposit as bail, comply with the bonding requirements of M.C.R. 12(b).
3. Any such cash deposits shall only be received at
 - a. The Sheriff's office or
 - b. By electronic direct deposit into an account designated by the Clerk of the District Court.

The Sheriff or deputy shall prepare a triplicate receipt stating the amount of the cash deposit paid, the offense involved, the name of the person charged, the name of the person paying the deposit, and the date, hour and minute paid. One copy of such receipt will be delivered to the person paying the deposit; one copy to be transmitted to the Clerk's criminal records office; and one copy retained by the Sheriff's office.

4. The Clerk's copy of the receipt shall either show the direct deposit of the cash to the designated account or be accompanied by the cash received or the Sheriff's check and shall be transmitted to the Clerk's office in the county in which received within twenty-four (24) hours after receipt.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that this order replaces Administrative Order E-DW.1 effective January 11, 1971.
