ORDER PRESCRIBING THE FUNCTIONS OF MISDEMEANOR PROBATION SERVICES

WHEREAS, Idaho Code § 31-878 provides that misdemeanor probation services shall perform such functions as prescribed by the Administrative District Judge in each judicial district and,


WHEREAS, the Court hereby identifies the function of misdemeanor supervised probation as the facilitation of the pro-social adjustments of offenders under supervision to prevent further criminal behavior and to ensure successful compliance with the terms and conditions of probation.

WHEREAS, the Idaho Association of Counties Misdemeanor Probation Planning Committee has approved and adopted Idaho Standard for Misdemeanor Probation Services, revised in 2023.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that each misdemeanor probation department in the First District shall establish, at a minimum, policies and procedures in accordance with the Idaho Standards.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that Administrative Order H10-DW.3 is rescinded.
