ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER  
H18-DW.1

In accordance with Idaho Court Administrative Rule 54.2 and Idaho Court Administrative Rule 54.3, all Guardians and Conservators shall file with the Court a report within 30 days following the anniversary of the appointment and at least annually thereafter.

The First Judicial District is participating in a district wide clean up that will require all Guardians and Conservators to be up-to-date on all Court required reports. Allowing Guardians and/or Conservators to pay one filing fee for multiple years' worth of reports may incentivize and encourage Guardians and/or Conservators to be in compliance with Idaho Court Administrative Rule 54.2.


ACCORDINGLY Guardians and/or Conservators who are more than two years delinquent on their annual reporting in the First Judicial District shall be exempt from paying each associated filing fee per year and will only be obligated to pay for one year's filing fee. This applies to the following:

- 1) Guardians and/or Conservators who do not have a signed Fee Waiver Order by the presiding Judge in their County.
- 2) Guardians and/or Conservators who are more than two years delinquent on their annual reports to the Court.

This order shall automatically terminate on July 1, 2020, after which an annual filing fee will be due for each filing year thereafter.
