**ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER
F25-DW.4**

**MANAGEMENT, SECURITY & CONDUCT OF PERSONS IN THE COURT BUILDINGS
& ANNEXES OF THE FIRST JUDICIAL DISTRICT; RESCIND F13-DW.1**

WHEREAS, the First Judicial District Court desires to maintain an efficient judiciary and to provide safeguards and protection of those individuals requiring the use of various Court buildings in the First Judicial District.

WHEREAS, the Court, having authority to control all actions and conduct within the various Court buildings in the First Judicial District, and to ensure the safety of said buildings and all persons therein, does hereby enter this Order to provide for all the management and security of the various courthouses in the district and the orderly conduct of all proceedings therein.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that all persons *except*:

- a) Duly employed court security officers and bona fide peace officers as defined in Idaho Code;
- b) Duly employed POST certified State of Idaho Probation and Parole officers in uniform with identification;
- c) Duly employed POST certified Adult Misdemeanor Probation officers in uniform with identification;
- d) Duly employed prosecutors and their support staff;
- e) Duly employed state public defenders and their support staff;

entering any courthouse in the First Judicial District are hereby prohibited bringing into the building any firearms, dangerous weapons, explosives, or incendiary devices. Prior written approval may be obtained by a resident judge upon a showing of good case for the necessity

to possess such an item. The foregoing does not apply to any such items held in the custody of the Clerk of the District Court as evidentiary exhibits.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that all persons entering or being in a courthouse building located in the First Judicial District, including, but not limited to, the official courtrooms therein, are hereby prohibited from uttering loud, threatening or abusive language or otherwise engaging in any disorderly or disruptive conduct, at any place within said building, or committing any act with intent to impede, disrupt or disturb the orderly conduct of any session of the Court or any other judicial body or tribunal holding a proceeding therein.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that any person entering any courthouse of the First Judicial District shall be subject to search by magnetometer and/or hand frisking. Further, any person in any courthouse of the First Judicial District shall be subject to a search by magnetometer and/or hand frisking at any time when ordered by a district or magistrate judge with authority to preside over proceedings in that courthouse.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that upon disclosure of this Order to any person committing any of the proscribed acts, unless such person immediately ceases and desists from committing the proscribed acts, and complies with any Order or direction of any peace officer or court security officer in furtherance of this Order, that such person shall be in risk of being in Contempt of Court and may be detained or arrested.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that any peace officer or court security officer observing a person acting in violation of this Order is hereby authorized to detain such person until officers of the appropriate law enforcement agency can take such person into custody to await a prosecution decision by the appropriate prosecuting authority.


IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that copies of this Order shall be posted at conspicuous places throughout courthouse buildings, District Court Clerks' offices and other buildings

which are considered to be annexes of a courthouse of the First Judicial District, to provide notice to all parties entering the courthouse or annex.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the presiding judge of a courtroom may further restrict persons from possessing firearms within that courtroom.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that Administrative Order F13.DW.1 is hereby rescinded.
