**WHEREAS**, *Idaho Code* §31-808 provides that property not exceeding \$250.00 in value be sold through a private sale without notice or public auction; and

**WHEREAS**, the Kootenai County Sheriff's Office has on its asset list One (1) 2019 Data Works Plus Livescan Plus System, Asset #7932, Serial Number CXTMoT2/BSC86R2/006002599 which is obsolete due to age, and/or is fully depreciated, and therefore have outlived its useful life for the Department and is of no further use to the County; and

**WHEREAS**, the estimated total value of the equipment is less than of \$250.00; and

**WHEREAS**, the Kootenai Sheriff's Office desires to have the above referenced property declared as surplus property, deleted from its asset list, and sold at private sale without notice or public auction;


